

EMS SCHOLARSHIP

The 9/11 Memorial Coalition formed after the terrorist attack that occurred on September 11th, 2001 when a motorcycle ride throughout many municipalities of Lycoming County Pa took place. Each year, on September 11th, the Coalition holds an annual Motorcycle ride through Lycoming County to honor and memorialize the sacrifices made by the first responders who gave their lives for strangers on that fateful day.

This scholarship is just one way that the 9/11 Memorial Coalition honors the memory of those EMS providers who lost their lives during the attacks.

The annual Scholarship will provide the funds necessary to enroll in the Emergency Medical Technician Course at the Pennsylvania College of Technology in Williamsport, Pa.

Name

9/11 Memorial Coalition EMS Scholarship

Requirements

Must be a resident of Lycoming County.

Must complete a scholarship application and submit by May 1st of each year.

Must submit background clearances with application.
(These are required to be accepted to the program)

1. Child Abuse
2. FBI Fingerprint
3. PA State Police

Selection

There shall be a minimum of two scholarships awarded per calendar year. In the amount of \$1,000 each and paid to the Pennsylvania College of Technology in the applicant's name.

Scholarship will not be retroactive to anyone.

Selection will not be determined by or based upon Sex, Race, Religion, Creed, or Financial Status.

Amount

\$1,000.00 total, one-time, per person, scholarship amount.

Funding

The 9/11 Memorial Coalition shall fund the scholarship program annually with proceeds from the 9/11 Memorial Motorcycle Ride.

Enacted

This scholarship program presented and enacted upon, March 20, 2018

Scholarship recipients will be requested to attend the annual 9/11 Memorial Service that is held prior to the annual Motorcycle Ride on September 11th each year.
